

Approved minutes of the Clyde Township Board Meeting – April 11, 2018.

The regular monthly meeting of the Clyde Township board was held at the Township Hall on Wednesday, April 11, 2018.

Audience: Judge Baillargeon, John Hollander, Rick McKellips, Kenny Clevenger, and Allison Bowden.

A motion by McLeod, supported by Larsen, to approve the March Board meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.
