

Approved minutes of the Clyde Township Board Meeting – June 8, 2016.

The regular monthly meeting of the Clyde Township board was held at the Township Hall on Wednesday, June 8, 2016.

Audience: Don Nagel, John Hollander, Jon Kramer, Abigail Nobel, Candidate for State Rep., Sheri Hurtman, and John Dingel III.

Roll Call: Members present – Tom Giles, Bob Larsen, Bernie McLeod, Chris McKellips, and Cathy Ptak. All members present.

A motion by Larsen, supported by McLeod, to approve the May Board meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.

Correspondence: None

A motion by McLeod, supported by Larsen to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried. The report is attached and is now part of the official minutes.

Bills were presented. A motion by McLeod, supported by McKellips, that we pay the bills as presented. Roll call vote – all yea's. Motion carried.

Fire Chief, Rick McKellips reported they had issues with equipment. The Jaws of Life will need to be replaced. He is looking into a used set. He is looking into electric rather than gas. They do not use the Jaws of Life as often as they used to due to the way new cars are built.

Don Nagel of the Ambulance Board submitted the new revised Fennville Area 911 Ambulance Service Contract. The subsidy will be reduced due to no Saugatuck participation. AMR will still run Priority 1 calls to them. A motion by Ptak, supported by Larsen to accept and approve the Fennville Area 911 Ambulance Revised Service Contract. Roll Call vote – all yea's. Motion carried.

Bernie McLeod of the Transfer Station had nothing new to report.

New Business: A **motion** by McKellips, supported by Ptak to remove Larsen from the Zoning Board of Appeals. Motion carried. A **motion** by McKellips, supported by Ptak to appoint Bill Busscher to the Zoning Board of Appeals. Motion carried. A **motion** by Larsen, supported by McLeod to appoint Bill Busscher to the Planning Commission to be effective immediately. Motion carried.

Jon Kramer of Kramer J. Services introduced himself to the Board he submitted a quote for his services of monthly cemetery maintenance in the Township and 1 fall Clean-up. The Board has a quote of 6 payments of \$1,000 per month for the next six months. A motion by McKellips, supported by Larsen, we accept the quote and approve Kramer J. Services for cemetery maintenance within the Township. Roll call vote – all yea's. Motion carried.

Public Comments: Resident, Sheri Hurtman introduced herself with a complaint of cemetery policy. Apparently her rose bushes were taken out and she would like to know why. There was some discussion regarding rules and regulations. The clerk will send a copy of the Ordinance that clearly

states the rules and regulations of the cemetery.

John Dingall III reported the road light is flickering at 56<sup>th</sup> Street and 113<sup>th</sup>. Supervisor Giles will report this to Consumers Energy.

Abigail Noble introduced herself and gave us a brief perspective of her beliefs and background. She is a candidate running for State Representative in the August 2, 2016 Election.
