Giles reported on the Severens Drain which is scheduled to be repaired. The Quote came in at 1.2 million dollars and it will be spread over 20 years. The repairs will begin next year.

Onken reported on the election held on November 8th. We had 729 voters out of 1581 registered voters. Everything went very well. Special thanks to the election inspectors!

Public Comments: Dan Zugel is still upset about nothing being done with regard to the Wilson Clean Up. We will be in touch with the Enforcement Officer and have him make this a priority.
