

Approved minutes of the Clyde Township Board Meeting – July 11, 2018.

The regular monthly meeting of the Clyde Township board was held at the Township Hall on Wednesday, July 11, 2018.

Audience: Don Nagel, Rick McKellips, Karen Barnes, Barb Birkholz, and Mary Whiteford

Roll Call: Members present – Tom Giles, Bob Larsen, Bernie McLeod, Chris McKellips, and Cathy Ptak. All members present.

A motion by McLeod, supported by Larsen, to approve the June Board meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.

Correspondence: A notification of Municipalities was received regarding #495 Severns Drain.

A motion by Larsen, supported by McLeod to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried. The report is attached and is now part of the official minutes.

Bills were presented. A motion by McLeod, supported by McKellips, that we pay the bills as presented. Roll call vote – all yea's. Motion carried.

Don Nagel of the Ambulance Board reported he had a meeting last month. He is hoping to finalize a contract in December to send out in March and hopefully have a proposal for the Board in June. The contract will end July 31, 2019. There was some discussion regarding Saugatuck's involvement.

Bernie McLeod of the Transfer Station would like to change the price of large trash containers that have been supplied by Chef Container from \$6 to \$12. Bags of garbage are \$3.00. McLeod believes we are losing money because residents are bringing large trash containers supplied by Chef Container to the transfer station to dump their garbage. A **motion** was made by Ptak, supported by McKellips, that we increase the charge for large trash containers to \$12.00. Motion carried.

Barb Birkholz and Karen Barnes addressed the Board with photos of the Hutchins Lake Public Beach with 4 new seating benches and ground work. An invoice was submitted for this project to be paid next month. Derek Hesse is responsible for building these benches to acquire his Eagle Scout project award.

Mary Whiteford addressed the Board. She has been in office for almost 2.5 years and is running again for State Representative of the 80th House District. Whiteford is very involved in the district and State Budget. There was discussion about road improvements in Clyde Township.
