

Approved minutes of the Clyde Township Board Meeting – June 10, 2020.

The regular monthly meeting of the Clyde Township board was held at the Township Hall on Wednesday, June 10, 2020 at 7:30 pm.

Audience: Don Nagel, Rick McKellips, Mark McKellips, Sam Callejas, and Myrene Koch

Roll Call: Members present – Tom Giles, Bob Larsen, Bernie McLeod, Chris McKellips, and Cathy Ptak. All members present.

A motion by Larsen, supported by McLeod, to approve the May Board meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.

A motion by McLeod supported by Larsen to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried. The report is attached and is now part of the official minutes.

Prosecuting Attorney, Myrene Koch was introduced. She is up for re-election in August. She has been working during this time of COVID and has been very busy keeping up with Executive Orders from the Governor's office. She takes a hard stance against repeat offenders and is proud of a grant that funded a canine advocate to help with kids testifying in court. She has been elected as a leader by the board of prosecuting attorney's association.

Fire Chief, Rick McKellips, stated things have been quiet recently.

Mark McKellips of the Cemetery Board reported the grass is getting tall at the cemetery and will need to have a discussion with John Kramer Services again.

Bernie McLeod of the Transfer station reported he had an agreement with Chef Container to have 2 dumpsters and 2 recycle bins but only has 1. Republic said they will take care of this.

Don Nagel of the Ambulance Board reported the change over from AMR to LIFE is going well. There was some discussion regarding some of the changes that will occur now that LIFE will be in this area. Nagel has a meeting tomorrow night and hopefully a contract will be finalized for August 1, 2020 which will include all new addendums that have been addressed. Chris McKellips asked if she could get some information regarding Ambulance insurance available to residents so she can include this in the tax newsletter.

New Business: Sam Callejas thanked the Board for allowing him to address his concerns regarding his dad's headstone and violations. He is disappointed that he did not receive a list of the rules when a payment was made for the plot. He also would like to see the cemetery rules posted on our website. Mr. Callejas would like a little more time to resolve this issue. The Board agreed that he could take care of this in a timely manner.
