Clyde Township has installed a secure drop box for taxes at the Township Hall. The Mail slot is located at the rear of the building – labeled “Mail”. Taxes paid by either money order or checks may be deposited in the mail slot. A receipt will be mailed.

Taxes may be paid in person on appointed days only as noted below:

The Township Treasurer will be at the Township Hall (back office) on the following dates and times to collect:

July 2022: Saturday, July 16 – 8:30 am until 11:00 am.

August 2022: Saturday, August 20 – 8:30 am until 11:00 am.

September 2022: 1) Saturday, September 10 – 8:30 am until 11:00 am

2) Wednesday, September 14 – 9:00 am until 5:00 pm* (last day without interest.

*** Closed between 12:00pm and 1:00pm for township business.**

Property taxes may be paid online using an electronic check for a \$3 fee or a credit/debit card with a 3% processing fee. Credit cards will be taken at the window during the above posted office hours. Otherwise you may pay online anytime by going to the Clyde Township website at www.clydetwp.com. There will be a link to the Point & Pay Program under Public Records and Pay Online Tab.

Please do not try to pay taxes at the Allegan County Treasurers office. Allegan County cannot accept local taxes. Taxes must be paid in Clyde Township until March 1, 2023.

Delinquent Property Tax Notice: A Delinquent Property Tax Notice is listed on any 2022 tax bill turned over to Allegan County on March 1, 2022 as delinquent. The notice is located in the Property Information section of the tax bill. Delinquent tax notices were mailed out by Allegan County in April 2022. This is a reminder there is still a balance due to Allegan County as of June. Local Treasurers cannot collect **2021 delinquent taxes, please call Allegan County Treasurer's Office at (269) 673-0260 for final balance due and payable to "Allegan County Treasurer"**.

Ambulance Service:

The Fennville Area Municipalities (including Clyde Township) entered into an ambulance contract with LIFE EMS Ambulance Services. Any resident wishing to sign up for LIFE Care Plus (Ambulance Membership Program) should contact LIFE EMS at (800) 499-9316 or go to www.lifeems.com for more information on this optional ambulance coverage. The annual fee is \$49 for residents with insurance or \$79 for residents without insurance.

Good news for Clyde – the USDA selected a large portion of Clyde Township for a Rural Digital Opportunity Fund grant. The Allegan County Legal Assistance Center provides information and explanations of these court processes and procedures, offering proper tools and assistance with necessary paperwork. The Allegan County Legal Assistance Center is currently open Mon – 9:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. assisting last patron at 3:00 p.m. Tues-Thurs 9:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. assisting the last patron at 4:00 p.m. Friday 8:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. assisting the last patron at noon.

The office is located at 113 Chestnut Street, Allegan - lower level of the Allegan County Court House.

Assistance is provided on a first come first serve basis and is free to all Allegan County residents and former residents who have a civil case, in Allegan County courts. Staff, interns and volunteers do not provide legal advice or represent anyone in court. They are however able to explain a person's legal options and the process they need to follow. An Attorney referral list is provided if legal advice is required.
